## ACREAGE TABLE

The table below helps calculate the number of rolls of fence required to enclose various acreage sizes. These are suggested guidelines assuming the square area to be fenced.

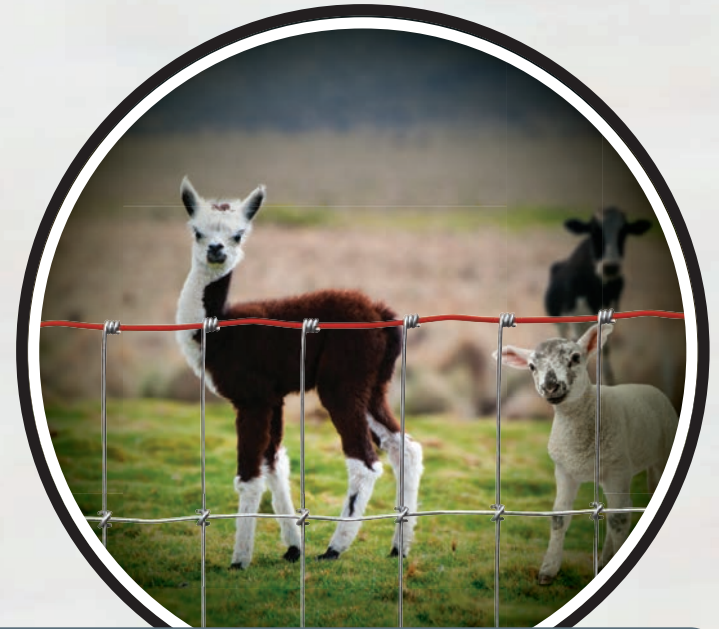

## ACREAGE TABLE

There are many types of fence that are designed as the best use for specific purposes (cattle, horses, sheep and goats, dog, garden) but some wire fences will restrain several species of farm animals. Imagine what purposes you may have in the future before selecting the type of fence you plan to install.

The larger the number, the smaller the wire.

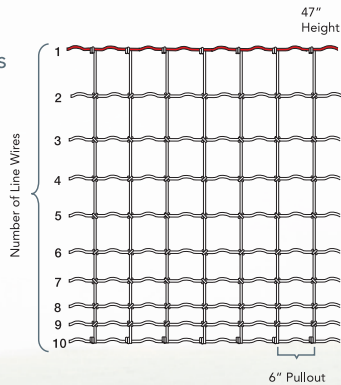

### CROSS LOCK® KNOT

The Cross Lock® Knot firmly affixes the fence wires together, providing superior resistance to movement from animal penetration or severe snowstorms.
